7th Grade Elective Course Descriptions

Creative Writing (Art Embedded)

This course is designed to provide instruction in basic language skills and integrates reading, writing, speaking, and listening while emphasizing art and individual student progress. Course content depends on the student's abilities entering the course. Instruction may include vocabulary building, spelling and grammar, writing and composition, reading silently or aloud, and improving listening and comprehension skills.

Body Conditioning

This course is designed for students to experience the different types of exercise and fitness. Students will explore the areas of cardiovascular exercise, aerobics, and other areas of fitness. Students will develop health and fitness skills that will help them maintain a healthy standard of life.

Science Olympiad

This introductory science course will focus on "hands-on science" introducing students to the world of scientific investigation. Students will use the scientific theory to explore, analyze, and reflect on the various Laws of Science.

Choir - Beginning

This course is for students with and without any musical experience. In this class you will learn several styles of music, music reading, theory, and proper voice technique.

World Cultures

This course is designed to celebrate diversity by promoting an awareness and understanding of world cultures. Students will foster a curiosity for other cultures, while building the foundation for multicultural learning.

Band - Beginning

This course is for students who have not had any previous band experience. Students will learn the fundamentals of instruments, music notation, and may perform at events.

Band - Intermediate

This course is for students who have had some band experience in elementary school or through private lessons. Students will continue practicing fundamentals of music reading, tone quality, and technique.

Math Academy Math 7

Math Academy is a math intervention course that supports students with their core math curriculum. This course is designed to 1) run concurrent with the student's Core Math Class, 2) Frontload math content from their Core Math Class, 3) using the same scope and sequence for that course, 4) Make connections and narrow gaps in mathematics knowledge and understanding, 5) Be an extension of the students Core Math Curriculum, not a standalone curriculum.
