## TRANSFER FAQ'S

- 1. When is the Open Enrollment window for 2021-2022?
  - We accept transfers from December 1, 2020 through January 15, 2021.
- 2. Can I put more than one school choice on the application?
  - Yes, you can put up to two choices.
- 3. Is every school open to transfer?
  - All transfers are based on space availability and grade level.
- 4. How is the approval decision made?
  - Approval is based on space availability.
- 5. If the transfer is denied, is there an appeal process?
  - No.
- 6. Is bussing available to the transfer school?
  - No. Transportation is the responsibility of the parent/quardian.
- 7. What if I already have a student at that school?
  - Every attempt will be made to place siblings at the same school within the capacity limitations of that grade, at that school.
- 8. How and when will I find out if the transfer was approved?
  - Decision letters will be available for downloading on PARENT CONNECT under STUDENT DOCUMENTS no later than May 15, 2021. If you do not receive a letter by May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021, please contact Student Services Department 951-736-5111.
- 9. Do I need to renew the transfer annually?
  - <u>If you live in the CNUSD attendance area</u>- No, the transfer is valid until matriculation, unless your student is promoting from Elementary to Intermediate, or Intermediate to High School.
    - <u>- If you live outside CNUSD attendance area</u> Yes, you will need to renew your transfer permit annually. Get a release from your home school district, and submit it to CNUSD District Office, Student Services, between December 1, 2020-January 15, 2021.
