GOALS FOR THE DISTRICT

EVALUATION OF DISTRICT GOALS

The Board of Education believes that a strong evaluation program is essential to the achievement of the goals and objectives of the Corona-Norco Unified School District. Toward this end the Board has directed that there be:

- A. Frequent formative evaluation of student progress,
- B. Hard data, such as test scores, as well as portfolios and subjective assessments,
- C. Anecdotal records/comments which are seen as helpful but not adequate,
- D. Timelines for all goals with established benchmarks,
- E. Persons named as responsible for all goals.

The primary purpose of an effective evaluation program is to produce information to improve student academic achievement. A secondary purpose is to evaluate the overall success of the curricular content and instructional methods in meeting the goals and objectives of the Board of Education.
