CHILD NUTRITION SERVICES

NON-CAFETERIA FOOD SALES

- A. No organization other than student organizations or Child Nutrition Services may sell food/beverage items on school campuses during school hours.
- B. Except for the Child Nutrition Services operation, the following rules are in effect from the beginning of the school day (12:01 a.m.) until after students return to class from the last lunch period of the day.
 - 1. No food/beverage item will be sold that has been prepared on campus (Home Economics classes/clubs).
 - 2. No food/beverage item will be sold that has been prepared in a private home (cake sales, etc.).
 - 3. No food/beverage item will be sold that has been purchased from private vendors (candy bars, carbonated beverages, vending machines, etc.).
- C. The Superintendent/designee may permit only one (1) student organization to sell a maximum of three (3) food/beverage items per school day from the nutritious list provided by the Child Nutrition Services program administrator. Foods sold may not be those sold by Child Nutrition Services.
- D. Vending Machines
 - 1. All vending machines located on the campus (excluding teachers' lounges/dining room or ROP food services) dispensing food/beverage items found on the minimal nutritional list must be locked until after students return to class from the last lunch period.
 - 2. For all vending machines a contract between the vending machine company and the school (or school district) shall be in writing and approved by the Assistant Superintendent, Business Services. A copy of the contract shall be kept on file in the district's Business Office.

3. All funds received from vending machines shall be deposited in a trust account. Appropriate records shall be kept for the expenditure of all such monies.
