STUDENT FUND AND FEES

A. Fees and Collections from Students

The Board of Education recognizes the responsibility imposed upon it by the State Constitution to maintain a free system of public education. For this reason, no fees or collections from students for instructional purposes shall be made.

The school district shall charge students in the shop, arts and crafts, and other similar programs for materials used on projects which are voluntarily selected and taken home. All such materials shall be sold to students at approximately the cost to the district. Students who lose or willfully damage school property shall reimburse the school district for the value of the damage or loss.

B. Student Body Accounts

The Assistant Superintendent, Business Services, shall be responsible for the supervision of all student body accounts.
